Road Safety – New Traffic Lights on Jalan Tengah (taken from BSP Bulletin system)

'BSP is committed to working with the local community to improve road safety. Brunei Tell-A-Friend is an example where we are working with the community to help improve road safety behaviours. One of the 5 Tell-A-Friend behaviours is to use pedestrian crossings to safely cross the road. In the past few weeks BSP has been working with the local authorities to install traffic lights on the road crossing of the Jalan Tengah near the G4/G5 housing area. The crossing is a known accident "black spot" and the traffic lights will make the crossing clearer to car drivers and will reduce the risk to pedestrians crossing the road. The final works before commissioning of the new lights is now nearing completion and is expected to be finished this weekend (the work is taking place at quiet times to minimise the risk to the workers and the disruption to traffic). The final acceptance by the Authorities will take place after completion of the work. Road users, both pedestrians and car drivers, are requested to take extra care during this transition while the final work is completed and before the new traffic lights are switched on. Additionally in the interim, guards are also stationed there to help supervise road crossing when needed.'
