Dear Parents,

Attached to this newsletter is an information sheet on the new traffic flow procedures at Teraja. Our aim is to ensure that all traffic flows to and from camp and the school safely.

We now have several crossings for pedestrians and bicycle riders around the school. These are in place to ensure that cyclist do not use the roundabout in front of the Mendaram building. **BSP HSSE staff have identified this roundabout as an unsafe place for pedestrians and bike riders to cross the road.**

Please support us by using the two new crossings in F6 and F5. The crossing in F5 (opposite No. 49) will be functional from Monday 1st May, as this is the date we will be close the rear entrance of the school, therefore, removing a large percentage of traffic from that road.
