International Day 2017-2018



2018/2019 Academic Year Class and Staff Planning

Further to our previous Parent Representatives meeting, the following provides a summary of key points discussed about the 2018/2019 academic year forecast.

With many variables potentially impacting our staffing model (which is predominantly the timing of changing student numbers) class lists and teacher locations for all classes in Pre-Nursery to P6 will not be presented until the week beginning 20th August 2018. This concept eliminates confusion, as throughout the end of year school break, class groupings may require altering a number of times.

In relation to class groupings, current predictions indicate the following student and class numbers:
